3. CHICHEN ITZÁ WITH IZAMAL

Explore the ancient capital of the Mayan empire, experience its extraordinary architectural beauty, and discover why it has been declared one of the wonders of the modern world.

4. UXMAL WITH CHOCOSTORY

Uxmal is known as "The threetimes built", it is located in an area of hills called Puuc, which breaks the monotony of the Yucatecan plain.

It is the most important city in the area as it had 20,000 inhabitants in its splendor (600 – 900 AD).

It is made up of 15 groups of buildings, highlighting the Pyramid of the Magician, the Quadrangle of the Nuns, and the Governor's Palace. Later we will visit the Chocolate Museum, an approach that goes towards the interactive side, where we will be the protagonists of the tour. The concept of the museum is to rescue the history of cocoa; from Mexico to the world in the middle of botanical gardens with cacao trees along the way.

6. CITY TOUR: MUSEUM MANZANERO HOUSE AND NATIVE HONEY EXPERIENCE

In the Plaza Grande in the center of the city, the Cathedral of San Idelfonso stands out, the oldest in the American continent on the mainland.

You will visit House Manzanero, which is the first official museum that pays tribute to the greatest artist that Yucatán has given: The master Armando Manzanero.

We continue to experience native honey. In the Yucatan Peninsula, we can find 17 of the 46 species of stingless bees registered in Mexico, some of them produce high-quality honey that has been used since ancient times as a supplement to the diet and for medicinal purposes.

7. MAGIC TOWNS: IZAMAL AND VALLADOLID

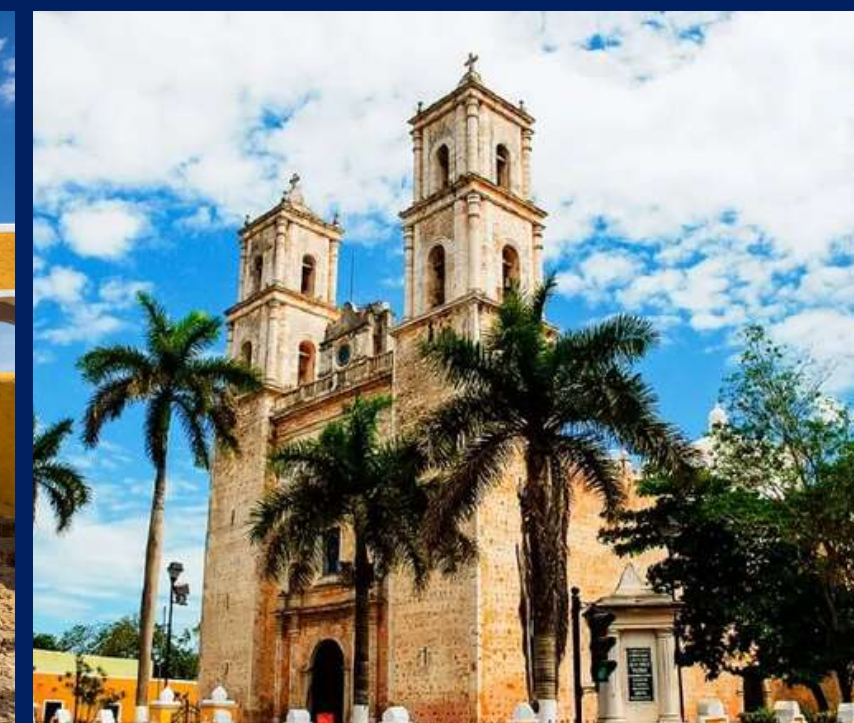
Izamal is known as the City of the Three Cultures since three historical periods coexist in it: its archaeological pyramids as a pillar of its Mayan heritage, the Franciscan Convent and its inhabitants. Founded in the middle of the 16th century, it includes walks through its beautiful and picturesque streets, gastronomy, crafts and its people.

Valladolid is an historical and heroic city, here, two of the biggest historic events in Mexico took place: The castas war in 1847 and the first spark of the Mexican Revolution in 1910. It's a beautiful colonial town with neighborhoods of great majesty and beauty, featuring the fortified convent of San Bernardino of Siena in the XVI century and the cathedral of San Gervasio baroque set of the XVIII century.

9. RESERVE OF THE CELESTUN BIOSPHERE

Place where the most exotic species of the Yucatecan geography coexist such as the pink flamingo, an endemic specie of Celestun.

The trips among the river are a spectacular experience leads to a meeting with the sea.

Along the Celestún River these pink flamingos can be admired. Then Bird island will be visited, where different bird species inhabit. You will go across the mangroves and visit the “eye od water”, where you will have the opportunity to take a shower for later disembark and head to get something to eat and enjoy the beach.

10. CENOTES OF SANTA BARBARA

The word "Cenote" comes from the Mayan "dzonoot" which means "abyss".

Cenotes are freshwater wells generated by the erosion of limestone. They are sacred places for the Mayan culture in which the underworld was accessed.

The cenotes of Santa Bárbara are one of the most beautiful since it is a set of three virgin cenotes that are within a complex that recently opened.

This cenote complex wonders that its characteristics are different, all surrounded by native flora and fauna, and have stairs to access without danger.

To visit them, there are two options: the ride in a truck (a cart pulled by horses), or by bicycle, which allows you to organize your time and learn more about the surroundings.

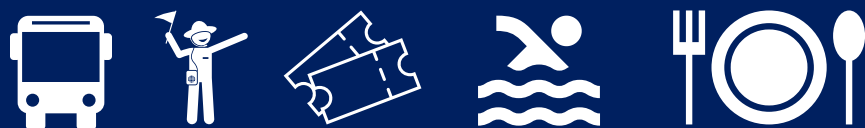

13. SOTUTA DE PEÓN

Traveling back in time will give us an idea of what Henequén once represented to the world. When touring Sotuta de Peón, our visitors will travel back in time, we will visit the facilities on wooden platforms called "Trucks" that are pulled by 'mules' on rails.

They will witness the step-by-step process of the transformation of the Henequén (or green gold, as it was known throughout the region), they will know a traditional Mayan House, and later they will visit the unique geological formations of our secret places: the Cenote of crystalline water. Finishing with a delicious meal in front of the main house.

14. MAYAPÁN AND CENOTES HACIENDA MUCUYCHE

The walled city of Mayapán, known as the "Flag of the Mayas", is considered the last great Mayan capital. It has an area of 4 km², in which there are approximately 4,000 structures. Its beginnings date back to the beginning of our era, reaching its maximum splendor in the Postclassic Period (1200 - 1450 AD).

This ex-henequen hacienda located in Mucuyché ("turtledove tree"), to the south of the state, shows its visitors the splendor of its partially restored buildings, but the most impressive are the cenotes it houses: the so-called Cenote Carlota, with a canal surrounded by vegetation; and the Cenote Azul, a cavern-type with stalactites still forming, two wonders that you can visit in Yucatan.
